


## ASHI Wilderness First Aid

<b>Intended Audience</b>	Community and Workplace — Wilderness trip leaders and guides. People who participate in more extended wilderness trips.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	None.
<b>ASHI-approved Training Materials</b>	<i>Wilderness Emergency Care</i> student text (1 per participant); Instructor Guide (one per Instructor.)
<b>Recommended Initial Instruction Time</b>	16–20 hours.
<b>Recommended Renewal Instruction Time</b>	8–10 hours.
<b>Maximum Student-to-Instructor Ratio</b>	10:1
<b>Student-to-Equipment Ratio</b>	2:1 for bandaging skills. Students should be encouraged to bring outdoor equipment they would have on trips to improvise splints.
<b>Successful Completion (certification)</b>	<b>Performance Evaluation:</b> Can reasonably perform skills/scenarios without continuous assistance.
